For 35 years, InfectoPharm has distinguished itself as a groundbreaking pioneer in various fields of indications. The portfolio currently comprises around 130 preparations with numerous innovations in the fields of pediatrics, dermatology, infectious diseases, pneumology and allergology, which are increasingly attracting international attention. The "consilium service" is available free of charge to specialists as a product-neutral advisory and knowledge transfer service.

The InfectoPharm Group is engaged in more than 30 international partnerships and is increasingly expanding into non-EU markets.
